

LNA Umpires Getting Started Guide

1. Complete your 'Rules of Netball' Exam

Email the certficate to:

lna.umpire@gmail.com & leschenaultnetball@gmail.com.

You are now on the waiting list pending the next intake of trainees

2. You will be contacted by LNA when you reach the top of the 'Green Shirt' waiting list.

You must be 12 years old, or turning 12 in the current season to commence training.

- 3. Register into the program via your online learning link by searching for Green Shirt Program.
- 4. Complete the beginners training as provided by the LNA Trainers.
- 5. Obtain your 'Green Shirt' for \$10 deposit. This must be worn whilst training.

Note: \$5 will be refunded at the end of the season if the shirt is returned in reasonable condition.

6. Advancement to 'Blue Shirt' is recommended

An appropriately qualified trainer will recommend the advancement to the 'Blue Shirt' level. The Umpire Coordinator will make the final decision on the advancement recommendation.

Umpires at this level must be able to control a game in the lowest levels of our Thursday night competition.

7. Umpires continue at 'Blue Shirt' level until they are ready to attempt their 'C' Badge.

Note: New umpires to LNA who can provide evidence that they are already badged ('C' or above) are not required to undertake the above program. All other umpires (regardless of their current or former training status) will commence the program at 'Green Shirt Level'.
